

VCR 8x8 'Dragon' for the Spanish Army starts production at General Dynamics European Land Systems - Santa Bárbara Sistemas

The Ministry of Defense awarded consortium Tess Defence the 'Dragon' program that envisages the manufacture of 348 units of the vehicle. US GDELS will manufacture in Asturias the barges for all the vehicles. The first phase of the program will require 900 direct jobs in Trubia factory, in addition to 4,500 indirect jobs. **Read more**.

#CircularEconomy: Asturian facilities of Bayer and the University of Oviedo are promoting a research programme to convert the calcium sulphate generated in the production of acetylsalicylic acid into gypsum for construction

#Sustainability: Glencore's Asturiana de Zinc and EDP signed agreements for the sale of electricity from wind farms for the next 19 years (2021-2040) The energy company will supply the San Juan de Nieva plant with 237 GWh per year.

#Health: Swedish AddLife acquires MBA SURGICAL EMPOWERMENT, a leading orthopaedic and trauma surgery business. The operation amounts to EUR 111 million. MBA started up in Asturias in 1988 and employs around 285 people.
