Acquisition: Celanese to acquire the majority of DuPont´
Mobility & Materials business.
This movement means the establishment of the US multinational in the Tamón Valley, Asturias.

Industry: Asturias was the Spanish region with the <u>highest</u> growth in industry production in 2021, recording an increase of 15.7% (more than double the national average of 7%).
