Ryanair returns to Asturias with flights to Rome, Brussels, Düsseldorf, Dublin, and London Stansted

The air connectivity programme by the Government of Asturias allows our region to have eight direct international routes as of 30 October, rising to ten by March 2023, the largest offer of international flights in the airport's history.

Biomedical | The technological multinational IZERTIS and the Foundation for Biosanitary Research and Innovation in Asturias FINBA join forces to generate medical-health research and innovation projects applied to biomedical technology.



Funding | The Government of Asturias announces grants for the implementation of action plans for business R&D&I centres. The centres must be part of business groups with the category of large company. Maximum total amount of the call is €3.000.000.

Phoenix Contact to recruit 30 highly qualified people in Asturias to create a software development centre

ENERGY TRANSITION

Iberdrola Renewables's first offshore foundations for the Saint-Brieuc offshore wind farm reached France recently. They were made and assembled at Navantia Seanergies—Windar Renovables's facilities in Brest and Fene, and the piles that anchor the turbines to the seabed, at Windar's facilities in Avilés, Asturias.



Leading Japanese firms explore opportunities for collaboration with Asturian companies in the green hydrogen sector. A trade mission launched by JETRO - Collaborate & Invest Japan meets with the Asturian engineering company DF-Duro Felguera and the HyDeal consortium.



The Spanish National Markets and Competition Commission approves Enagás' starting-up of the regasification plant at the Port of Gijón. This facility will operate to facilitate the transit of LNG tankers to the rest of Europe to supply liquefied natural gas to other parts of the continent, mainly Northern Europe.



DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

The EU Commission supports the Asturias Digital Innovation Hub #AsDIH with a grant of €890,000

This grant will strengthen the management of AsDIH and expand its lines of assistance in order to offer a highly specialized service to support digital transformation.



The Government of Asturias will invest 90 million euros to digitize the public Administration

The “Asturias, Digital Territory” Plan will offer a new form of efficient, agile and proactive processing, promoting transparency and digital empowerment of society and businesses.
