



Highlights, facts, and news about foreign investment in Asturias during May 2021.

MAY IN THE NEWS

#Hydrogen: Asturian Government presents to European Commission a project to produce green hydrogen in collaboration with 19 energy and industrial companies.

#Innovation: Nestlé, the world's largest food group, has chosen its factory in Sebares (Asturias) to lead the production of Wunda, its first vegan milk, in the European market.

#Industry40: Asturiana de Zinc (Glencore) to improve the energy efficiency of its zinc factory with an investment of more than 100 million euros.

#OpenInnovation40: a new edition of this program led by IDEPA is underway with the participation of Corteva Agriscience, Aleastur, Capital Energy, COGERSA, ENCE, and Zitron.

#Shipbuilding: Mexican Grupomar contracts a 20.5 million tuna ship to Astilleros Armón and will order another one. This ship will employ 200 people a day for two years.

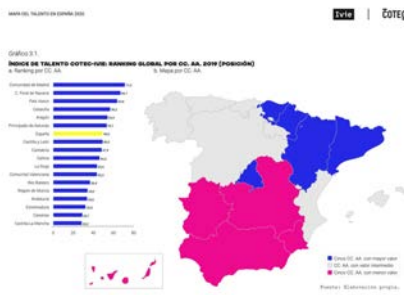


IN DEPTH
