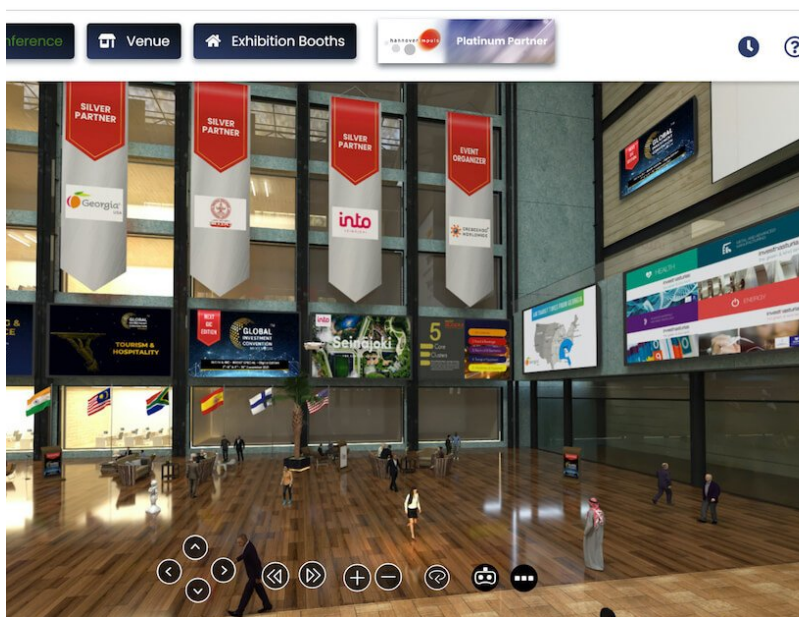

OCTOBER IN THE NEWS

#Connections: Vueling Airlines puts into service the Paris-Only – Asturias route. The Government of Asturias has also launched a tender to open new routes to London, Brussels, Milan, Dusseldorf, Lisbon, and Barcelona.

#FDI: French multinational Saint-Gobain to invest 3.7 million € in the repair of the float furnace at the factory in Avilés, a key part of Asturian glassmaking network because it supplies glass to the finished product lines.

#Industry: Asturias leads the growth of industrial production in Spain. The Industrial Production Index increased by 17.4% in August compared to the same month last year (vs. 3.6% on average in Spain as a whole).

DID YOU KNOW?



Asturian city of Gijón is among the ten best cities to start a business in Spain.

According to data from a study by the European savings platform Raisin España, Gijón scores positively on issues such as the quality of its academic centres, the overall number of businesses, GDP per capita, exports, and population.
